### Reception Screening to take place the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of March

Every year in England, school children in reception have their height and weight checked at school. Information is collected because it is important to monitor the health of children for public health purposes and to ensure parents have the best information about how they can bring up healthy and happy children.
